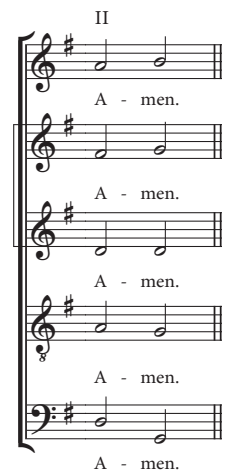
The COLLECTS

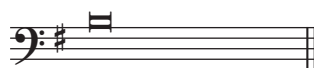

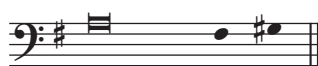

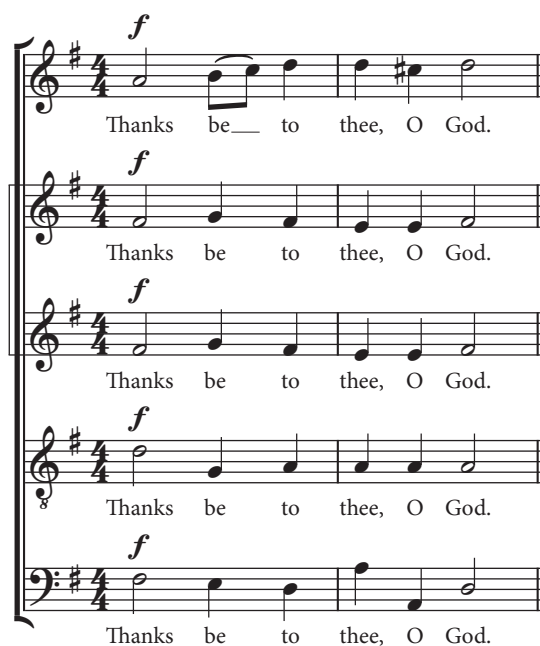
